In regards to county ordinance passed December 2nd, 2014 that amended chapter 11A of the code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to prohibit discrimination in housing, public accommodations and employment based on gender identity or gender expression, I would like to respectfully request response to the following questions.

- 1. If an officer arrests a biological male subject and said subject requests to be taken to a woman's correctional facility, and the officer refuses. Has this officer violated the above referenced ordinance? If no, why?
- 2. Can a biological male walk into a female only spa and watch women disrobe, change, and shower?
- 3. Can a biological male request for a female officer or agent to frisk him?
- 4. Can a biological male enter into a female <u>only</u> public bathroom with several stalls where children use the restroom?
- 5. Can a biological male follow a female child into the multi-stall female only bathroom?
- 6. If a private business owner or public parks manager asks a biological male to leave a female <u>only</u> restroom, is he violating the ordinance? If no, why?
